Attend this summer music festival that boasts 80+ bands on 20+ stages over 2 days.

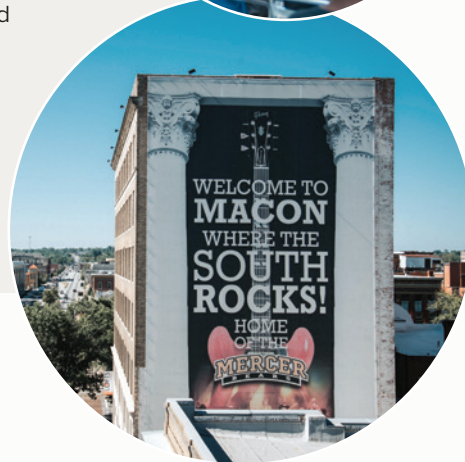
International Cherry Blossom Festival

As you prepare to transfer, Mercer is committed to making the application process easy by providing support every step of the way.

APPLICATION

Transfer students must submit an application for admission and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 for all college coursework to have a competitive application.

· Apply using either the Mercer Application or The Common Application at apply.mercer.edu and submit all supporting documents:

- › College transcript(s)
- › Official high school transcript(s) with graduation date | *Required for students with 60 or fewer semester/trimester credit hours or 72 quarter credit hours*
- › ACT/SAT scores | *Required for students with fewer than 30 credit hours*

COURSE CREDITS

Our transfer credit policy helps you make a smooth transition to Mercer, ensuring your academic success and keeping you on track for graduation.

- Mercer will accept coursework with a grade of C or better that was completed at a regionally accredited institution.
- Mercer does not transfer any institutionally-based, remedial, developmental, or vocational courses.
- The maximum credit allowed from all two-year colleges attended is 64 hours.
- Students must earn a minimum of 32 credit hours at Mercer to be eligible for graduation.

The Office of the Registrar completes an official credit evaluation approximately two weeks after a student has been accepted to the University. A transfer course that does not have a specific equivalent will be posted on your academic record as an elective course.

FINANCIAL AID OPPORTUNITIES

Ranked by *U.S. News & World Report* among the “Best Value Schools” in the nation, Mercer awards annual merit scholarships to transfer students entering the traditional undergraduate program on the Macon campus based on academic credentials provided in the application for admission.

GPA Range	Annual Scholarship
3.5-4.0 GPA	\$12,500
3.25-3.49 GPA	\$10,500
3.0-3.24 GPA	\$9,000
2.5-2.99 GPA	\$6,000



Students with exceptional academic credentials or Phi Theta Kappa membership may be eligible for special scholarships.

Qualified summer and fall transfer students may also participate in scholarship competitions.

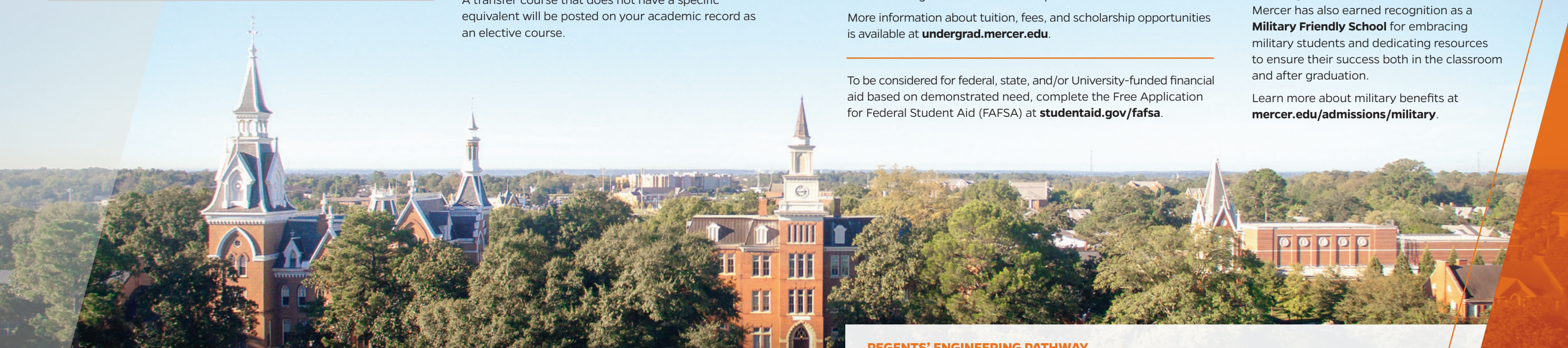

REGENTS' ENGINEERING PATHWAY

The Regents' Engineering Pathway (REP) program offers transfer students the opportunity to earn a degree from Mercer's School of Engineering.

To be eligible for the program, students must:

- Transfer from an REP partner institution within the University System of Georgia
- Complete pre-calculus with a grade of C or better
- Maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5
- Earn a minimum 2.5 GPA in all degree-relevant college mathematics, science, and engineering courses attempted
